Core Concept:

Rasiel is an increasingly unusual leader. He becomes Nombeko Overseer very suddenly, soon after becoming Reed Clan Patriarch. Unlike past Reed Clan Patriarchs, Rasiel is not large or strong. He's not particularly fast nor good at hunting or taking down eagles. He is small, fluffy, and very pink. His main claim to power was based on his intelligence and wisdom.

For all his life, most of his information came via his foresight magic and thus he relies on it a lot (to the extent of coming up with very creative ways to use his magic). But, soon after his rise to power, came the magic-less Winter, and following that, the Scarlet (where he found his foresight being magically blocked). Both scenarios caused him immense stress since his only source of information was taken away from him.

Rasiel does not regret or doublethink his decisions. And, his decision to push for a Shadow-Nombeko Alliance is not one he regrets or doubts. However, following the turbulence caused by this action, Rasiel goes to Gaophos to ask for godly reinforcement.

Rasiel reflects a lot of Gaophos' values: intelligence over brawn. So, the Nombeko god decides to amuse Rasiel, to see what kind of trouble the tom can stir up. In exchange for permanently surrendering his physical abilities, Rasiel is granted more sources of knowledge. However, with it, Rasiel is indirectly labelled by Gaophos as his pet.

Major/Minor Change Descriptions:

Tertiary and Quadruple Magics

- This is the main source of change. Rasiel will be granted both Lektor and Ghoul magic – which, combined with his Foresight, gives him the main “mental/knowledge” magic strains.
- They are maxed out so Rasiel can start causing “trouble” right away.
- Maxed Out Lektor important so he can “heal” minds immediately as well.
- Again, they are limited in their physical capabilities.

Physical Changes

- Wings Mutation – Birds are Gaophos’ pets. Birds have wings. Therefore, Rasiel shall have wings. They are combined with the multiple mutations so Rasiel cannot hide them, and reinforces his Nombeko bloodline (as multiples are generally Nombeko specific).

Divine Blessing/Curse Cap

Major Cap |

- Strength and Agility are permanently capped at Basic. (/19)
- Gaophos values brains over brawn, by gifting Rasiel with more mental abilities, he takes away some of his physical ones.
- Two new magics, two less physical abilities.

Minor Cap |

- Wings are symbolic of Rasiel’s relationship with Gaophos and nothing more. He can hover for short periods of time but is incapable of actual flight.
- Note: Rasiel does not like the wings! He would despise what they represent.

Reason for Blessing/Curse

After a few seasons where Rasiel's magic has been hindered, and having made controversial decisions, Rasiel goes to Gaophos to ask for reinforcement. Rasiel represents Gaophos's image of an ideal Nombeko, and has shown the willingness to go against the norm. Therefore, Gaophos decides to amuse him, and see what kind of trouble he can cause with more knowledge. (Also Gaophos may be curious to find out how long Rasiel he survive against the eagles without the ability to fight them or run away.)

Divine Build-Up

- Rasiel becomes Nombeko Overseer very quickly, with a general lack of actual leadership experience. He gains this position leaning on his foresight and general intellect.
- However with the Magic-less Winter and the Scarlet, both hindering his access to knowledge via Foresight, Rasiel becomes increasingly distressed, feeling like he has been left without a crutch to lean on.
- After coming to the controversial agreement to form a Nombeko-Shadow alliance, Rasiel goes to Gaophos for his backing.
 - Rasiel does not wish for war to break out in Nombeko and will go to extraordinary lengths to avoid it.
 - He just wishes that others will see things the way he does and that they'd trust him a bit more

Post-Divine Blessing/Curse

- Rasiel uses his new magics to teach other Nombekos the value of knowledge.
- Being able to have more information (and with Gaophos' blessing), Rasiel will hopefully increase the clan leaders' trust in him and survive in a leadership position for longer no matter what controversial decisions he makes.
- He will continue to back the Shadow Vanguard, trying to convince others of his decision without the use of violence.
- Nevertheless, Rasiel will remain firmly Nombeko-first for as long as he is Overseer.
 - He will build alliances when beneficial, but challenge other herds with no fear.
 - The DB will give him the final confidence boost he needs to challenge the Saraphs face-on about their kidnapping of Nombekos to Slavery.
 - In the far future, Rasiel will use his knowledge to teach all Anomali about their past, their future, magic, gods, logic, etc.

World Effects

- This will help increase the narrative trend of herd leaders having DB/DC. Opening future, anomali-wide plotlines.
- Rasiel will start to be considered more "threatening" than just being a small, pink, fluff.

- He will have almost unlimited access to information. Foresight covering the future, Lektor revealing “hidden thoughts” and the present, and Ghoul giving him direct access to the spirits of the past.
- Foresight = Future, Lektor = Present, Ghoul = Past
